The section titled Disclosure Required by CBE of the State [Bar] of California on page 59 has been revised as follows:

“The method of instruction at this law school for the Juris Doctor (JD) degree program is principally by correspondence.

Students enrolled in the JD program at this law school who successfully complete the first year of law study must pass the First-Year Law Students’ Examination required by Business and Professions Code §6060(h) and Title 4, Division 1, Chapter 1, Rule 4.3(I) of the Rules of the State Bar of California as part of the requirements to qualify to take the California Bar Examination.”
